



K-8 Tuition Information

Catholic Schools exist to form young people to be faithful disciples of Christ. Sacred Heart of Jesus is a Catholic School rooted in Scripture and the Tradition of the Roman Catholic Church. By providing an excellent Catholic education to our children, we are responding to God's call to serve one another and share our gift of faith.

Sacred Heart of Jesus School offers a tiered tuition plan to demonstrate our commitment to students and their parents. Families with two children will receive a 10% discount on their second child's tuition. Families with three or more children will receive a 20% discount on the third child and every subsequent child.

Discounted tuition is available for families who meet the Actively Affiliated Catholic Family Qualifications*

- **2 CHILDREN: \$15,371**
- **3 CHILDREN: \$21,843**

Non-Affiliated Tuition, Grades K-8 (Non-Affiliated families now qualify for multiple-student discount)

- **1 CHILD: \$10,526**
- **2 CHILDREN: \$19,999**
- **3 CHILDREN: \$28,420**

Tuition for 2026-2027 includes all fees except lunches, school supplies, uniforms, after school care, fees for retreats, field trips and the 6th 7th and 8th grade trips.

***Requirements for Actively Affiliated Catholic Families as defined by the Archdiocese of Denver:**

- Family must be registered at SHJ or another Catholic parish for at least 6 months.
- Family verifiably contributes on a regular basis to the financial support of the parish through the use of electronic or envelope tithing.
- Family attends Sunday Mass regularly and is involved in the activities, organizations and livelihood of the parish.

Please note: Your student will not be officially enrolled at Sacred Heart of Jesus School for the 2026–2027 school year until all required enrollment forms have been submitted, and the \$300.00 enrollment deposit has been paid.

Financial Assistance

SHJ offers several generous options to meet the needs of students who require assistance to attend our school. The typical awards range from \$500-\$3,500 and recipients must apply each year for aid. Families seeking tuition assistance must complete the following:

1. Financial Assistance is available for grades K-8 only. Preschool and PreK families may be considered for a tuition reduction by completing a Financial Assistance Application through Denver Catholic Schools Variable Tuition Program (VTP -see below).
2. Applicants must be admitted/re-enrolled to Sacred Heart of Jesus School via FACTS before they can be considered for assistance.
3. All families seeking financial aid and/or needs-based and merit-based scholarships MUST complete the VTP. Aid is granted on a first come, first served basis. Apply online: <https://denvercatholicschools.com/variable-tuition-program/>
4. Families qualifying for ACE or Schmitz Scholarships MUST complete the FACTS Grant and Aid application by March 31st. There is a \$35 FACTS processing fee to complete the Grant and Aid application and you will need to submit your 2025 W-2 from and tax information. 5. Families applying for Sacred Heart of Jesus School Foundation Scholarships MUST submit their application by Friday, March 21st. Applications may be picked up in the school office.

6. Tuition contracts will not reflect scholarship awards until August 1st, 2026. Families will be notified of their scholarship by means of an award meeting with School Leadership prior to the end of the current school year.

7. Students and families are required to uphold the Sacred Heart of Jesus School's Code of Conduct in order to remain eligible for tuition assistance.

¹Registration completion: Your student(s) are automatically registered on March 1, 2026 unless written notification has been provided to the school office stating that your student(s) will not be returning. Additionally, your re-enrollment packet must be completed by this date or a \$100 late fee will be charged to your account.

²Your \$300 Registration fee will be charged to your FACTS account on your tuition payment date in March unless you have provided written notice to the school that your student(s) will not be returning. If you have an automatic payment plan, the non-refundable fee will be deducted along with your March tuition payment, if you do not have an automatic payment plan, you will be invoiced.

³Families affiliated with Catholic parishes other than Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish must turn in Parish Affiliation forms. If you are an actively affiliated parishioner at a parish other than Sacred Heart of Jesus, print the Parish Affiliation form and have your pastor sign it; upload it to your FACTS portal or turn it into the school office when you complete your re-enrollment packet. The parish affiliation form must be submitted at this time in order for you to receive the affiliated rate. The pastor and business office will verify SHJ parishioner families' affiliations based on parishioner records.

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
